Spring in to Action!

Our Spring Monthly Supporter Campaign is dedicated to closing the gap in our annual budget deficit of \$600,000. In FY 2021- 2022 alone, Crisis House served 5,456 people and ended homelessness for 292 families with 365 children. Our Camp Hope program supports 125 children and youth traumatized by domestic abuse with year-round mentoring and activities, counseling, and camperships.

If you were to contribute \$88 a month, you would provide the unforgettable experience of one week of overnight summer camp for one of our deserving Camp HOPE participants!

\$125 a month would provide bedding, small appliances, and other furnishings for a family in our domestic violence programs starting their new life in their new apartment!

\$280 a month would cover the monthly cost of diapers for one child in our New Journey transitional housing program for women with children fleeing domestic violence.

\$435.40 a month would cover the costs of one activity (like kayaking, museums, college tours, art) for one age group of Camp HOPE participants for one month!
