El Cajon Housing Connections Renewed!



Karina Hernandez has been with Crisis House for nearly three years. In January, when Crisis House partnered with the city of El Cajon to provide Housing Connections, she became the "El Cajon Housing Connections, Housing Navigator."

This program has been a huge success! The goal for the year was to house 25 households. During the first six months, Karina housed 47 individuals and 29 households, which included 15 children. Last Thursday, at the City council meeting, the city recommended that funding for this program continue. We are proud of Karina and the work that she has been able to do in this community. We are also grateful that we will continue to have the funds to offer housing solutions to the men, women, and children who are experiencing homelessness in El Cajon.

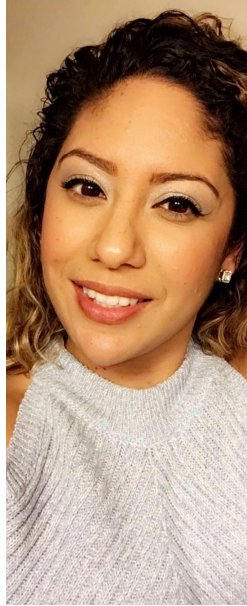


Captain Rob Ransweiler
